Mount Ararat's Community Activity Center

Hours of operation are Monday-Friday 6:30 am – 6:00 pm. Programs and services available to the community:

After-School Programs: Over 125
 students are served daily.. Our
 program provides tutoring, computer
 training, and recreational activities.

Mount Ararat's Community Activity Center

- Community Service Program: offers a Food and Clothing Bank to families in need. Approximately 100 families are served each month.
- Farly Childhood Development Center: offers a comprehensive educational program 45 children are served daily.

Mount Ararat's Community Activity Center

- Mentoring Programs are designed to assist both middle school and high school students. Goals are to enhance academic achievement, and promote career and college readiness. Approximately 150 students are served.
- Seniors Program offers educational, recreational, and social. Over 200 seniors participated in activities.

Mount Ararat's Community Activity Center

"Camp Harambee" Youth Summer Day Camp

- Provides educational, cultural, recreational, and creative activities for youth ages 5-14 for eight weeks.
- Activities include academic instruction, recreational & cultural field trips, and service learning. Approximately 210 youth participated.

- After-School & Mentoring Programs
 - 21st Century Westinghouse High School Middle school students receive homework support.
 - 28 students are enrolled
 - Supplemental education includes: writing, research, STEM lab projects
- Promotes college & high school readiness, exposure to a variety of careers and standards necessary for students to receive the Pittsburgh Promise Scholarship Funds.
 - 46 Mentors (37 Female/9 Male)

After-School & Mentoring Programs

- Mentee Breakdown By School:
 - 20 Colfax (6 males/14 females)
 - 27 Sterrett (10 males/17 females)
 - · 23 Obama (14 males/9 females)

- Mount Ararat Middle School Mentoring Program
 Promotes strong Christian values through small group mentoring, educational support, community service and field trips.
 - o 12 Mentors
 - o 30 Mentees
 - Student Participants
 - 4 Students Pittsburgh Obama
 - 5 Students Westinghouse Academy
 - 10 Students Sterrett Academy
 - 1 Student Colfax
 - 10 Students (a variety of other schools that come directly to MACAC)

- High School Professional Development Academy Provides tutoring, homework help, character development, career readiness and financial literacy.
 - o 19 Students Pittsburgh Obama
 - 28 Students Westinghouse Academy
 Total Students: 47
 - Students who meet monthly requirements for attendance and performance receive a stipend of \$5 per day.
 - A trip to New York City is currently being planned for June 16-17, 2017.
